instead. Despite with all the	e effort to hold the Japai	nese, Singapore had surre	ndered on 1942	with less than a
week of fighting. The Japan	n occupation lasted for t	hree years and eight mont	hs with the retu	rn of the British
in 1945. After the war, Sing	gapore became a British	Colony.		
Singapore had joined Mala	ysia for a short time in 19	963 when the British left,	but Singapore le	eft Malaysia and
became independent on 9 A	August 1965. Since then,	Singapore's economy boo	m for the subsec	quent forty years
and become one of the four	East Asian Tigers.
