In the afternoon of September 27, a super typhoon named Noru hit the mainland of central Vietnam. Noru, according to the government, would be the strongest storm in Vietnam over the past two decades.

Although people were aware of the danger, there was severe property damage. The strong winds blew away thousands of house roofs and washed away a large number of facilities. The streets were flooded because of the heavy rains. Over 5,000 big trees fell across the road. The storm also destroyed all crops and fish farming. Rainstorms and landslides in mountainous areas made life difficult for the locals. According to reports, at least 10,000 homes were in trouble. The typhoon had a huge impact; however, governmental officers and volunteers from different parts of the country worked hard to improve local people's living conditions after the typhoon. Schools, shops, offices and farms quickly reopened.
