Unlike traditional classes whose lectures are scheduled at a specific time of the day, learners of distance courses can decide their own schedule so that it fits their working hours. Secondly, virtual learning helps learners to save a lot of money. For example, they can get the right qualifications without having to traveling a long distance, therefore reducing transportation costs. Some universities also offer students enrolling in online programmes a discount off the regular tuition fees. Finally, students have access to course materials repeatedly.
