However, her mother took great care of her with patience and love. She used to hang out with the daughter of the family cook using the sign language of their own. Afterwards, Helen was examined by Alexander Graham Bell at the age of 6. As a result, he sent to her a 20-year-old teacher, Anne Sullivan from the Perkins Institution for the Blind in Boston, which Bell's son-in-law directed. Sullivan, a remarkable teacher, remained with Keller from March 1887 until **her** own death in October 1936.
