The Earth's climate changed dramatically due to human activity in the 20th century, and it will continue to do so in the future. Decreasing greenhouse gas emissions might help mitigate the effects of the climate crisis. However, with rising emissions, the impacts of climate change are expected to be even more severe in the 21st century.

Climate change results from rising surface temperatures, also known as global warming. This is caused by the greenhouse effect, a process in which Earth's atmosphere retains heat due to rising amounts of greenhouse gases like carbon dioxide and methane. The year 2023 was the hottest year ever recorded, with temperatures approximately 1.48 degrees Celsius higher than pre-industrial levels in the 19th century.

To what extent will the temperature rise? Climate Science Special Report, a US global change research program, states that by the end of the 21st century, temperatures might rise by five degrees Celsius or more. Sharp cuts in greenhouse gas emissions, however, may limit global warming to 2 degrees Celsius or less.
