Moreover, AI contributes to global collaboration by processing large volumes of conservation data. Viet Nam has collaborated with international organisations to use AI in mapping biodiversity hotspots. By analysing satellite imagery, AI systems provide insights into habitat loss and recommend strategies for restoration. These partnerships have significantly enhanced Viet Nam's conservation capabilities, making the country a model for integrating technology into wildlife preservation.

Although AI presents many opportunities, challenges remain.
